




We strive to build and grow our endowment to better support student scholarships, enhance faculty compensation, and maintain our distinctive campus setting.

Avon attracts talented and dedicated men and women who fulfill and honor our mission by providing special learning experiences both in and out of the classroom.







Jennings/Fairchild Rink renovation, phases one and two, improve the player/fan experience. -Phase 1: 2018-19 School Year, Phase 2: TBD








